

PURPOSE

The City of Garden City has a Program available to its residents called the Rent-A-Truck Program.

The Rent-A-Truck Program allows homeowners to use a City dump truck to clean up their property for a minimum charge of **\$30.00**.

The Rent-A-Truck Program runs **April 1—September 30**.

Instead of waiting for the Spring and/or Fall Clean-Ups to do major cleaning projects around your property, you can utilize the “Rent-A-Truck”.

You can reserve a truck for a weeknight or for a weekend.

City workers will park a City dump truck on your property and pick it up the next business day.

The City of Garden City believes the Rent-A-Truck Program is very helpful to the residents of the City.

Weekend Reservations

City workers will deliver the City dump truck Friday afternoon and pick up the truck first thing Monday morning.

Guidelines

- ⇒ Program is available from April 1 - September 30
- ⇒ The "Rent-A-Truck" Program is available to Garden City residents only - no commercial addresses
- ⇒ Prepayment of **\$30.00** is required before noon the day of delivery of the dump truck
- ⇒ Trucks may not be reserved by the same individual or family more than once a week, unless there is no waiting list
- ⇒ Appliances using Freon require a certificate showing that it has been decharged

RENT-A-TRUCK



Restricted

Residents may not dispose of the following items:

- ⇒ Tires
- ⇒ Vehicle motors or batteries
- ⇒ Liquid paints
- ⇒ Appliances using FREON, unless they have been decharged
- ⇒ Grass clippings, leaves
- ⇒ Hazardous waste materials
- ⇒ Petroleum products
- ⇒ Shingles or roofing material
- ⇒ Building demolition debris
- ⇒ Contractor materials (tree trimming, home remodeling, appliances, etc). Contractors are responsible for the removal of service
- ⇒ Concrete, brick or sod
