

Micro Utility Vehicle Inspection Checklist

To be registered for use on city streets, micro utility vehicles must be inspected for the following equipment requirements:

- Head lamps
- Tail lamps
- Registration tag light
- Reflectors-rear
- Stop lamps
- Turn signals
- Spot, fog, auxiliary, driving lamps
- Stop and signal lamps; color, visibility
- Braking systems for motor vehicles
- Horns and warning devices
- Mirror: left side of vehicle
- Mirror: right side or inside center
- Safety belts and shoulder harnesses
- Restrictions as to tire equipment
- Mufflers and noise suppressing systems

Micro Utility Vehicles on City Streets



Would you like to drive your Micro Utility Vehicle on city streets? Here's what you need to know.

In 2013, the City Commission passed Ordinance No. 2588-2013 allowing the operation of registered micro utility trucks on certain streets within city limits.


To register your MUV:

- Call the Garden City Police Department at (620) 276-1300 to make an appointment to have your vehicle inspected.
- Take your MUV, as well as proof of insurance, to the police department for inspection.
- Pay the one-time registration fee (\$25)



The registration plate must be displayed on the micro utility truck at all times that it is operated on any public highway or street in the city.

Micro Utility Vehicles cannot be operated on the following streets as indicated in red on the map. The vehicles can cross the streets but cannot drive on them:



- Main Street (Business 83) south of Kansas Avenue
- Kansas Avenue east of Taylor Avenue
- Fulton Street East of Main Street
- Highway 50
- Highway 83
- Taylor Avenue north of Kansas Avenue
